David– A man after God’s own heart

How we remember David:

- Shepherd boy anointed as king over all of Israel
- Great warrior who killed Goliath
- Man who took another man’s wife, Then had that man killed so he could marry her
- Great poet and song writer

How God remembers David:

Acts 13:22 – “A man after God’s own heart”

David seeks God in his life above all else:

“What does God want me to do?”

“What kind of person does God want me to be?”

God looks at David and sees a person of integrity and character

Humility: A lowly shepherd caring for sheep in the field – faithful to his task when no one is looking

Brave: Faced Goliath when everyone else was afraid to face him

“What giant? The only Giant in my life is God.”

David was a sinner:

1) Affair with married woman  
Arranged to have her husband killed in battle so he could marry her

2) He is confronted and convicted of his sin

3) Repents before God – his suffering evident in Psalms 32 and 51

David applies to us today:

We are blessed by God

We are called to a certain way of life  
and service to him

We are sinners who do not always  
do what God wants

We can repent and return to the  
Lord

Once we realize that God has  
blessed, forgiven and renewed us,  
we must seek greater and deeper  
ways to honor him

2 Samuel 7:1-3

David commits to honoring God by  
caring for God's house equally or  
greater than he cares for his own
